Your Hortiki Plants' Pet Grass kit contains a mix of barely, oats, rye, and wheat seeds. All of these grasses are non-toxic to cats and dogs and safe for consumption. While there is a need for more published scientific research on the topic of pet grass, all relevant studies to date conclude that grass eating by your pets is a normal and common behavior.

WHY:


Dogs and cats eat grass because it is evolutionary, instinctual behavior. Dogs are omnivores meaning they regularly eat both meat and plant material. Cats are carnivores, meaning they eat only meat. However, even in the wild, during the process of hunting and eating, cats ingest plant material.

BENEFITS:

Plant material contains fiber that can aid in digestion, Plants also have antioxidants, vitamins, and even some protein. Additionally, for pets today who spend most or even all of their time indoors, plants can help them relieve stress.

NO WORRIES:

Pet grass is a safe way for your pets to indulge in plants without the fear of them ingesting toxic material outdoors. If your pets try eating pet grass and vomit afterwards, don't be too alarmed. It may take several weeks for their systems to adapt and reap the digestive benefits.





WOODEN CONTAINER AND LEAK GUARD Use the decorative wooden container with the leak quard to keep surfaces clean and dry.

PREP SOIL

Soak soil and drain well. Place soil in wooden container with leak guard, reserving about 1/4 cup to cover seeds after planting.

PLANT SEEDS

Spread seeds generously in a thin layer on top of soil. Lightly press to secure then cover with a thin layer of soil. Pat lightly again to secure. Place in a warm location. Keep away from pets until grass is growing so seeds are not disturbed.

WATER GENTLY

Water sprouts gently every 1-2 days (or when top half inch of soil feels dry).



MONITOR HEAT, LIGHT, MOISTURE

Pet grass doesn't need a ton of light, but place in your sunniest available window to maximize growth. Check on your pet garden daily. Keep soil moist but not soaking wet.

GIFT TO YOUR PET

Grass should be ready in 5-10 days. Allow your pet access and enjoy their enjoyment!

RESEED

To plant new seeds using the same soil: Empty soil from container and gently break-up. The roots from previous plant growth will eventually decompose adding nutrients to the soil. Soak the soil and squeeze out excess moisture. Plant new seeds and keep growing!
